FAQs – Frequently Asked Questions



You are allowed to select ONE eLearning course per year in grades 11 and 12.

You'll log in using your student number and password.

Under "My Courses", select "Online Learning Student Orientation Module" to see what eLearning courses look like and begin your orientation.

Yes – You are allowed to select eLearning course as an alternate for your grade 11 or 12 year.

All eLearning courses are OPTIONAL and NOT mandatory.

It is recommended that you stay at school to work on your course during the allotted 'eLearning time slot' that will be assigned. The teacher librarian is available to help with any challenges you may face.

If notifications are received that indicate you are not keeping up with the pace of the work assigned, you will be required to remain in the library for support.

Final examinations and projects are at the discretion of the eLearning course teacher.
